Revolutionary War heroes **William Dawes, Jr.**, a forgotten Midnight Rider of 1775, and **General Joseph Warren**, slain during the Battle of Bunker Hill, have found their eternal rest in this sacred landscape. The Civil War Soldiers' Lot, dedicated to Roxbury men killed in that war, also honors other patriots who died after they returned home. The simple monument of **William Lloyd Garrison**, editor of the *Liberator*, is a neighbor to **Edward Everett Hale**, author of Man Without a Country, and within a comfortable stroll to the stone of African American historian, **William Cooper Nell**.
