The Office is open, but no interments or other services are available on —

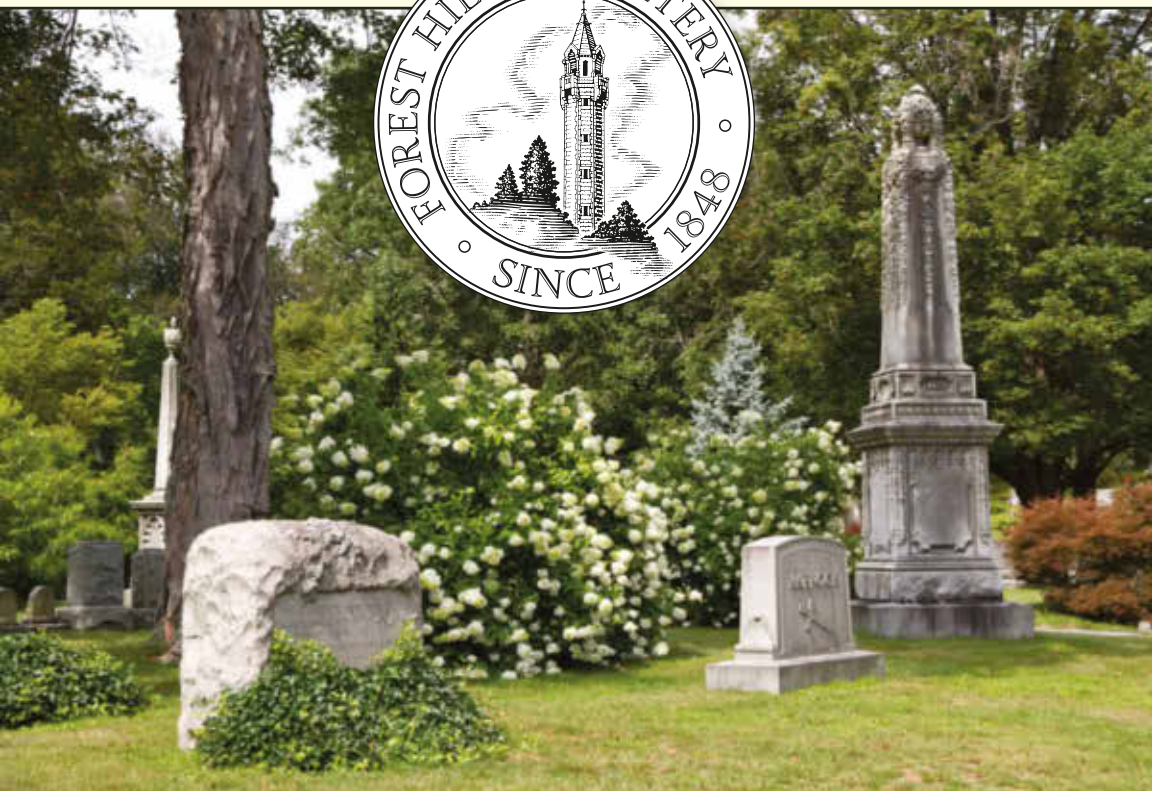
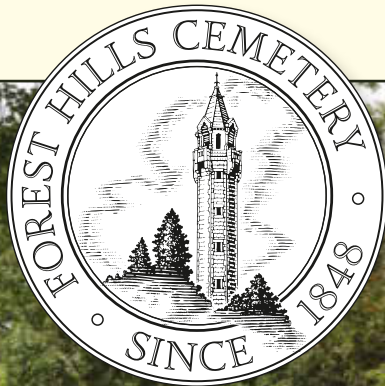
Patriots' Day and Memorial Day.

The Dearborn Pavilion is harmoniously designed with a serene courtyard garden and fountain — enhancing the peaceful ambience of this newly created feature of New England's premier rural garden cemetery. The original Gothic Revival Receiving Tomb built in 1871 now forms the central focal point which graces this classic setting, and is available for services prior to placement.
